#### Presentation

- Darren Tuck, Principal, Calling Lake presented a powerpoint on Calling All Readers: Calling Lake "Successes." The powerpoint included pictures of students enjoying Daily 5, Storytellers, students reading to each other, reading together, parents reading to the students, and art showcasing paper mache masks, paintings of rainbow sneakers and plasticine cd cases. It also featured the RCMP simulating a rollover and talked about seat belt safety, the Remembrance Day service, a cake walk and Christmas concert. Approximately 300 people enjoyed the Christmas dinner: there were Pow Wow dancers and the Elders did a smudge. Calling Lake has an after school program with activities such as: baking, volleyball and distance learning.
- The Board heard a presentation on Apple Schools from Nandia Narine, Teacher, St. Theresa School. Apple Schools is an organization run through the School of Public Health at the University of Alberta This program is funded by Allan Martin and promotes health and nutrition. The launch has been very successful and would be a great project to share with other schools.
- Rick Horon, Pedagogical Supervisor presented an Assessment Committee update. In January 2012, the Alberta Assessment Consortium (AAC) provided a proposal to Northland School Division to support assessment related initiatives within the Division. Specifically to develop an Assessment and Reporting Policy and accompanying Administrative Procedures and to develop a plan to support implementation of the Policy and Procedures based on the understanding that the Northland Pedagogical Supervisors (PEDS) would play an integral role in the implementation process at the division level. A committee was formed and they have met four times to discuss Divisional Assessment Policy, Assessment and Reporting Policy and report cards.
- Donna Barrett, Superintendent presented to the Board My Child's Learning: A Parent Resource from Alberta Education. This resource provides parents with a better understanding of Alberta's curriculum and how parents can help their children. The resource shows what your child is learning, how they are assessed and what resources are available to help them be successful from Kindergarten to Grade 12. http://www.learnalberta.ca/content/mychildslearning/
- Gail Sajo, Literacy Coordinator presented a powerpoint on the second round of data received from the PM Benchmarks. Most schools are showing incremental growth and the students, with teacher support, are closing the gap. The findings will be shared with principals and teachers to develop an action plan. We will be in servicing the staff on guided reading; how to do it effectively and strategy groupings so they can make the best of their time with the students.
