Quarterly Financial Report Presentation

Secretary Treasurer Trudy Rasmuson unveiled a new Financial Quarterly Report format. The report will provide the Northland Board detailed information about revenue sources, program spending, expenditures, historical revenue, historical expenses and year to date reports. The new format is recommended by the Alberta School Boards Association (ASBA) and is designed to make help the Northland Board interpret information easier.

Procedure Approval Highlights

- The Northland Board approved changing the Regular Board Meeting dates from November 28 and 29, 2014 to November 21 and 22, 2014.
- The Northland Board approved the priorities for the 2014-2015 school year. The priorities include Implementation of the Attendance Improvement Initiative, Establishment of a Literacy Focus Group, and the development of a long-term vision for education in Wabasca-Desmarais. These priorities will be included in the 2014-2017 Three Education Plan.
- The Northland Board approved the terms of reference for the Literacy Focus Group. The terms of reference includes reviewing student progress, monitor how schools implement literacy plans and recommendations and develop a communications strategy for Literacy.
- The Northland Board approved revised job descriptions for the positions of Transportation Manager, Transportation Coordinator and Facilities and Transportation Secretary.
