Visit with Edmonton Public Schools highlighted in the Board Chair Report

A visit with Edmonton Public Schools (EPSB) is highlighted the Board Chair Report. The NSD Board of Trustees met with the EPSB Board for the first time on Thursday, April 19th. The meeting ignited conversations about student transition between the school divisions, student achievement and staff support. Following the meeting, NSD and EPSD committed to working on strategic plans to support the topics discussed.

Board Chair Maddy Daniels, Ward 8 Trustee Loretta Gladue and Superintendent of Schools Gord Atkinson attended the National School Boards Association Conference April 7-9, 2018 in San Antonio, Texas.

Daniels specifically talked about a session where schools have transitioned to an 11-month calendar. She said schools made the change to minimize learning loss students experience during summer break. The presentation mentioned schools on the 11-month calendar had an easier time identifying learners who need extra help and saw an increase in graduation rates. Atkinson and Board Chair Daniels participated in a Superintendent Compensation Survey with Alberta Education. They provided information about NSD they haven't before and highlighted unique needs and challenges.

Atkinson noted a special evening for few NSD schools. Students from Conklin, Chipewyan Lake and Pelican Mountain Schools attended an Edmonton Oilers game on March 24th. Thanks to Canadian Tire Jumpstart and the Oilers, the students watched from the comfort of Connor's Corner; a six seat theatre box behind the Oilers net.

In addition to providing student attendance information, Atkinson said he will be involved in interviewing candidates for the Director of Student Engagement, Attendance and Completion position.
